When you want to balance the heritage and the modern, opt for the welded option with its traditional streamline mitred corners.



Both top and bottom panes tilt inwards when required, a feature that makes the outer glass easy to keep clean as well as adding additional ventilation.

Child safety catches can be fitted if required, to keep your family safe.
